In the event that work requires operatives to work less than 2m from each other, they must wear a three layer face covering. No physical contact will take place</li> <li>Non-essential physical work that requires close contact between workers must not be carried out</li> <li>Work requiring skin to skin contact must not be carried out</li> <li>All other work is planned to minimise contact between workers</li> <li>Re-usable PPE must be thoroughly cleaned after use and not shared between workers</li> <li>Single use PPE must be disposed of so that it cannot be reused</li> <li>Holding meetings in open areas where possible.</li> </ul>
